

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR 3-PIECE ZIP ON SYSTEM



1

UNPACK YOUR STORMCOVER ROOF PANEL AND TWO SIDE PANELS NEXT TO YOUR VEHICLE/RV.

ROLL THE ROOF PANEL SECTION OVER THE ROOF OF YOUR VEHICLE/RV FROM FRONT TO BACK.

SECURE THE ROOF SECTION IN POSITION WITH THE STRAPS & SLIDE BUCKLES SEWN INTO THE STORMCOVER.

ZIP THE SIDES OF THE STORMCOVER ONTO THE ROOF SECTION FROM BACK TO FRONT (NOT FRONT TO BACK AS SHOWN IN THE PHOTO). PRESS DOWN THE HOOK AND LOOP PROTECTIVE STRIP.

IF YOU HAVE ORDERED A SEPARATE DOOR PANEL, THIS CAN BE FULLY ZIPPED OUT FOR EASY DOOR ACCESS.

IF YOU HAVE ORDERED A SEPARATE HITCH AND DRAWBAR COVER, THIS CAN NOW BE APPLIED FOR COMPLETE COVERAGE. REAR WHEEL COVERS, GROUND WHEEL COVERS AND GAS BOTTLE COVERS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE.



CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS



MAINTAINING YOUR STORMCOVER

To help maintain and prolong the life of your Stormcover, the following tips should be observed:

- Keep the outside Tarpee® layer of your Stormcover clean by regularly brushing it using a soft-bristle brush and hosing occasionally with clear and cold water.
- Do not apply detergents, cleaning fluids, soaps or any types of insecticides and garden sprays.
- Do not allow foreign matter; dirt, bird droppings, tree sap etc, to remain in contact with your Stormcover.
- Do not allow petrochemicals or solvents to come into contact with your Stormcover.
- Avoid harsh scrubbing or rubbing otherwise the surface of your Stormcover may become damaged.
- Before storing your Stormcover, ensure the entire cover is thoroughly dry.

Caring for Zips on your Stormcover

- Be gentle with your zippers and never force them past a close or snag.
- Don't expose your zippers to harmful cleaning chemicals.
- Clean zippers regularly with water and a mild detergent to remove dirt and salt.
- To prevent future problems, apply a lubricant to zippers after cleaning.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUBBORN STAINS ON THE OUTER TARPEE® LAYER OF YOUR STORMCOVER

1. Mix a weak concentration of household PH neutral detergent (1:20 ratio) in lukewarm water. (NB: The detergent must not contain solvents.)
2. Apply the detergent and water mix to the fabric using a soft cloth, sponge, soft-bristle brush or soft mop. After cleaning, rinse off ALL residue with plenty of fresh clear, cold water.

OTHER HELPFUL TIPS

- Never clean your Stormcover with high pressure spray cleaners e.g Gerni.
